

This writ petition is filed under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India praying to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus to the respondents to issue permanent account number and card in favour of the petitioner in his capacity as the executor of the estate of the Rangaswamy Narasimhan.

This writ petition coming on for Preliminary Hearing this day, the Court made the following :-

ORDER

In this writ petition the petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue permanent account number and



card in favour of the petitioner in his capacity of Executor of Estate of R.Narasimhan.

2. As per the Annexure-B petitioner filed Form No. 49A for issue of PAN Card on 19-08-2009. Till today the respondents have not passed any order on the application filed by the petitioner. Therefore, a writ mandamus is hereby issued to respondents to pass appropriate order in accordance with law on the application of the petitioner as expeditiously as possible and in any event not later than three weeks' from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

3. The petitioner is also at liberty to file petition before the respondents seeking modification of the PAN Card which is in the name of deceased R.Narasimhan. If such a representation is given by the petitioner then the same shall be



considered by the respondents within a time frame of three weeks.

With the above observation, the writ petition is disposed of.
