

Taxpayers can view the details of their Arrear Demand in 'My Account' as communicated by their jurisdictional Assessing Officers to CPC.

For ease of taxpayers, Income Tax Authority launched a facility to view the Arrears of Demand online on the e-filing website i.e. <https://incometaxindiaefiling.gov.in/portal/index.jsp>. The detail relates to arrear-demand uploaded by respective jurisdictional AOs and adjustment made by CPC thereafter. For any discrepancies, please contact your Jurisdictional AO.

The steps to view Arrear of Demand online are:

1. Login on the e-filing website
2. Go to '**My Account**' and Click on '**Current Status of Arrear Demand**' as illustrated in image below:



3. A New window will appear as shown below:
