## DEREGULATION OF INTEREST RATES ON NON-RESIDENT (EXTERNAL) RUPEE (NRE) DEPOSITS

## CIRCULAR DBOD. NO. DIR.BC.71/13.03.00/2013-14, DATED 29-11-2013

Please refer to our circular <u>DBOD</u>. <u>Dir</u>. <u>BC</u>. 40/13.03.00/2013-14 dated <u>August 14</u>, 2013 allowing banks the freedom to offer interest rates on incremental NRE deposits with maturity of 3 years and above without any ceiling in order to pass on the benefit of exemption provided on such deposits from CRR/ SLR requirements. In terms of para 4 thereof, these instructions are valid up to November 30, 2013, subject to review.

- **2.** In this connection, we advise that the above instructions issued vide circular under reference will remain unchanged till January 31, 2014, subject to review.
- **3.** An amending directive DBOD.Dir.BC.70/13.03.00/2013-14 dated November 29, 2013 is enclosed. (Annexure)
