

Sensex continues to decline for 3rd day, drops 131 points

MUMBAI: The S&P BSE benchmark [sensex](#) dropped further for the 3rd day in the late morning session, moving down 131 points due to persistent selling pressure mainly in auto, metal, IT, and Banking sectors on the back of lower global cues.

The sensex resumed lower at 21,101.05 and hovered in a range of 21,103.80 and 21,004.89 before quoting at 21,040.69 at 1030 hrs, showing a loss of 130.72 points or 0.62 per cent from its last close.

The NSE 50-share Nifty also dropped 42.30 points or 0.67 per cent to 6,265.60 at 1030hrs.
