Notice Inviting Fresh Tenders

On behalf of Governor of J&K State tenders are invited on e-tendering mode from the Chartered Accountants empanelled with Comptroller and Auditor general of India for carrying out "Internal Audit" of PMGSY flagship Programme in J&K State for the period from 2010-11 to 2011-12 and current financial year 2012-13 (both under Programme Fund and Administrative Expenses Fund) funded by Ministry of rural Development, Government of India. The proposal for Internal Audit shall be submitted in two parts viz Technical and Financial in the forms provided in formats detailed in tender documents separately for Kashmir region and Jammu region or for both regions in joint depending upon the capacity and manpower of the firm. Other details are given in the tender documents.

Terms and Conditions:-

1. The Bidding-documents can be downloaded from the website <http://pmgsytenders.jk.gov.in> from 05-09-2012 (10:00 AM) to 16-09-2012 (4:00 PM)
 2. The bids shall be deposited in electronic format on the website <http://pmgsytenders.jk.gov.in> from 16-09-2012 (10:00 AM) to 20-09-2012 (4:00 PM). The bids uploaded on the web site up to due date and time will be opened on 21-09-2012 (2:00 PM) in the presence of bidders who wish to attend. If the office happens to be closed on the date of opening of the bids as specified, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.
 3. The complete bidding process will be online.
 4. Bids of bidders shall be opened on line in the office of Chief Engineer PMGSY (JKRRDA) Kashmir at Engineering Complex, Bund Road, Rajbagh, Srinagar on 16-09-2012 (2:00 PM).
 5. Bidding document can be seen at and downloaded from the website. <http://pmgsytenders.jkgov.in>, bidding documents contain qualifying criteria for bidders, bill of quantities, conditions and other details.
 6. Bids must be accompanied by bid security Rs. 10000/- and cost of document Rs. 500/- pledged to Accounts Officer PMGSY, Kashmir payable at Srinagar and shall be valid at least for 120 days from the date of opening bids.
- (Note: The fee on account of downloaded bidding documents shall be acceptable in form of Demand draft only and bid security in form of FDR/CDR.)
7. The hard copy of original instruments in respect of cost documents, bid security must be delivered to the Chief Engineer, PMGSY (JKRRDA), Kashmir at Engineering Complex, Bund Road, Rajbagh, Srinagar on or before 20-09-2012 (4:00 PM). If the office happens to be closed on the date of opening of the bids as specified, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.
 8. The offer shall be inclusive of all charges within the state and nothing extra shall be paid.
 9. Other details can be seen in the bidding document available online.

Instruction to Bidders regarding e-tendering process.

1. The interested bidders can download the bid from the website <http://pmgsytendersjk.gov.in>
2. To participate in bidding process, bidders have to get "Digital Signature Certificate" (DSC) as per information Technology Act-2000, to participate in online bidding. The certificate will be required for digitally signing the bid. The Bidders, who already possess valid (DSC) Digital signature certificate, need not to procure new Digital Signature Certificate.
3. The bidders have to submit their bids online in electronic format with Digital signature. The cannot be uploaded without Digital Signature Certificate. No proposal will be accepted in physical form.
4. Bid will be opened online as per time schedule mentioned in Para 2.
5. Before submission on online bids, bidders must ensure that scanned copy of all the necessary documents have been attached with bid.
6. The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission of bids whatsoever reasons may be.
7. All the required information for bid must be filled and submitted online.
8. Bidders should get ready with the scanned copies of cost of documents and HMD as specified in the tender documents. The original instruments in respect of cost of documents, EMD and relevant documents be submitted to the Tender Inviting Authority by Registered Post/courier as per time schedule specified.
9. The details of cost of documents, EMD specified in the tender documents should be the same as submitted online (Scanned Copies) otherwise bid will not be accepted.
10. Bidders can contact the undersigned for any guidance for getting DSC or any other relevant details in respect of e-tendering process.
